Subject: Report to State Board meeting Saturday, October 5, 2013

Since the last division report Lake County Division 1 has accomplished the following:

1. Conducted division meetings each month (Lake Co Div 1 meets 12 times per year).
2. Elected Officers: President – Patrick Kennedy, Vice President – Joe Farrell, Recording Secretary – Mike Shilale, Financial Secretary – Patrick Hoey, Chairman of the Standing Committee – Finbarr McGrath, Marshal – Lou Emond and Sentinel – Frank Noonan. Appointed Historian – Tom Farrell and WebMaster – Mike Shilale.
3. Initiated Joe Nichols, Michael Lethbridge, and Michael Sheehe and reinstated Brother Pete Shaughnessy.
4. Closed two bank accounts at Wells Fargo Bank and opened two at Regions Bank.
5. Planned and executed a money making pancake breakfast at Havana Country Club. Netted \$1150 for our charitable use.
6. Conducted Irish History essay contest open to Jr. and Sr. High School students. Awarded \$300 First Prize to Tara Mazza.
7. Solicited proclamations from Marian, Lake and Sumter Counties and the cities of Bellview, Fruitland Park, Lady Lake, Leesburg, and Wildwood proclaiming March 2013 Irish Appreciation Month.
8. Marched in the “Spanish Springs” St. Patrick’s Day Parade. Last year we fielded 9 marchers in our own formation and contributed an additional 4 to other formations (bands, etc.) This year we were 19 strong in our own formation with an additional 6 others marching elsewhere in the parade
9. Attended a corporate communion service at St. Mark’s, St. Vincent DePaul’s, St. Paul’s and St. Timothy’s Churches. Our prayers specifically for the following intentions: protection of the faith, priests in peril, vocations, brother Hibernians, reunification of Ireland, and for St. Mary, the Blessed Virgin to visit the United States. It is our plan to visit each of the five surrounding parishes twice a year at six-month intervals during their adoration of Blessed Sacrament for this purpose and so they will see their Hibernians in action.
